

TRANSIT OF EMBARGO COMMODITIES

We are pleased to introduce the possibility to transport embargo commodities through the CIS countries with GPS sealed containers.

To transport embargo commodities through the CIS, the following information and documents are required in advance to check and confirm:

- HS code (10-numbers) for each cargo incl. net/gross weight
- Information about each container with details about stowage (package, unit size, weight, etc.)
- Port of loading (POL) \ railway station \ place of departure
- Port of destination (POD) \ railway station \ place of arrival
- Copy of veterinary\phytosanitary certificate with following information: description of the cargo, net\gross weight, quantity, shipper's name, consignee's name, place of departure, place of destination, container number, seal number, kind of transportation
- Copy of certificate of origin with HS code (8-numbers) and following information: cargo description, net\gross weight, quantity, shipper's name, consignee's name, country of origin, invoice number, container number. **Certificate of origin must be issued extra for each container!**
- Copy of packing list, invoice with information about HS code (10-numbers), cargo description\cargo name, net\gross weight, quantity, number of veterinary certificate, shipper's name, consignee's name – **absolutely identical in all the cargo documents!**
- Information about owner of the containers and country of register of the containers

If booking is confirmed, the following cargo documents are required:

- The original veterinary certificate must be sent together with cargo/with container
- The original certificate of origin with HS code (8-numbers) must be sent together with cargo\with container
- Originals of packing list, invoice and railway bill with information about HS code (10-numbers), cargo description and net\gross weight, quantity, number of veterinary certificate, number of certificate of origin, shipper's name, consignee's name – **absolutely identical in all the cargo documents!** – must be sent together with container
- Packing list must show trademark, name of cargo, its features, quantity of the cargo, net\gross weight, date of manufacture and valid time.

For import to China the following documents are required to prevent any problems at the outway border point:

- Copy of the legal business license and activity of the Chinese consignee
- Label on the package in English and Chinese
- Records in the special base about import to China and sales

Except for the information and documents mentioned above, the Chinese importer/consignee must confirm all documents (except certificates) in advance with his own stamp.

Based on our experience, the embargo cargo took about 6 days in transit, just like normal transit goods between Dostyk and Brest. The current procedure is conceived for the transit of individual containers.
